Media Lab, Inc. ("Media Lab")'s Ex Parte Application for Turnover Order was presented to this Court on November 2, 2010. The Court has considered the Application for Turnover Order, Media Lab's Memorandum of Points and Authorities in Support of the Application for Turnover Order, the Declaration of Jeffrey M. Rosenfeld in Support of the Application for Turnover Order, and the relevant statutory and case law, and the Court hereby concludes that, good cause appearing:

1. IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT Media Lab's Ex Parte Application for Turnover Order is GRANTED.

2. IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED THAT Defendant and Judgment Debtor Laura Collis *dba* LC Internet Marketing *dba* LC Internet Marketing, LLC *dba* Goingtocalifornia.com *dba* California-Amusement-Parks.com ("Collis") shall transfer the domain names identified in Exhibit A to Media Lab, to be sold at public auction in coordination with United States Marshal, located at U.S. Courthouse/Phillip Burton Building, 450 Golden Gate Avenue, Room 20-6888, San Francisco, CA 94102.

3. IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED THAT Network Solutions, Inc., the registrar for the Domain Names shall take reasonable steps to ensure the turnover of the Domain Names to Media Lab pursuant to this Order.

4. **Pursuant to California Code of Civil Procedure Section 699.040, failure to comply with this Order may subject Judgment Debtor to arrest and punishment for contempt of the Court.**

5. IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED THAT the United States Marshal shall act as a levying officer, pursuant to California Code of Civil Procedure Section 699.070.

6. **Plaintiff shall serve a copy of this order on defendant pursuant to Cal. Code**
